*Care and support for Communities Affected by HIV/AIDS in Africa*

1. KIFARU COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT (KICODET) in Tanzania: \$68,484 eighteen month grant, to support the National Aging Policy to establish and strengthen grandparents and vulnerable children in semi rural settings.
2. INDIGO WOMEN'S LINK in Tanzania: \$ 86,033 for twelve months to strengthen Voluntary Counseling & Testing in four semi urban regions.
3. CHILDREN & YOUTH DEVELOPMENT in Tanzania: \$89,773 grant for twelve months aimed at reducing the prevalence of HIV infection and AIDS morbidity & mortality among Adolescent and youth in /out of school.
